And has affected many.

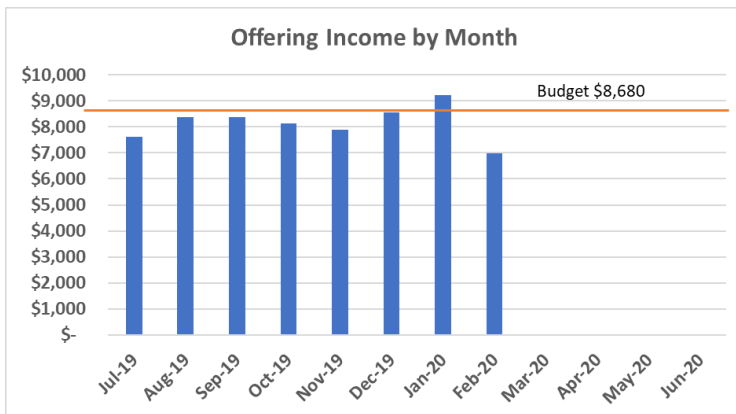
We pray for your grace
