Opening Prayer

Jesus Ministers to Crowds of People

²³ Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and curing every disease and every sickness among the people. ²⁴ So his fame spread throughout all Syria, and they brought to him all the sick, those who were afflicted with various diseases and pains, demoniacs, epileptics, and paralytics, and he cured them. ²⁵ And great crowds followed him from Galilee, the Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and from beyond the Jordan.

Prayers of the people

- 3. For pastors who are wrestling with how to minister to their congregations.
- 4. For churches whose existence may not survive this crisis. We pray for the extra pressure this virus has put on pastoral care and finances of our churches.
- 5. For church members and others who've lost their jobs. We pray for those who have already been let go and others who have been notified. Still others are working a declining number of hours, and they don't know what the future holds. Seemingly within days, everything has changed.
- 6. For church members and others whose retirement income seems to be disappearing. The concerns for the financial security of many make our hearts heavy plentiful God.
- 7. **For non-believers who have no real direction to turn.** We lift up those who have no faith and no purpose in life. Draw them to you in this time of crisis Almighty God
- 8. For God to heal the sick, comfort the grieving and give peace to the dying.
